Aleksandar Jokić i Negosava Stojković

Lekari Specijalne bolnice za rehabilitaciju Banja Koviljača, Prim. dr Negosava Stojković, dečiji fizijatar i Prim. mr sci. med dr Aleksandar Jokić, fizijatar-balneoklimatolog, bili su specijalni gosti ovogodišnje manifestacije. Kao predavači po pozivu, oni su dobili priliku da upoznaju posetioce ove manifestacije sa iskustvima lečenja u Banji Koviljači, lidera u zdravstvenom turizmu Srbije.

Ceo naš aranžman organizovalo je tursko ministarstvo za kulturu i turizam, a preko ambasade u Beogradu.

Prvog dana je održan panel turskog udruženja banja o trendovima u banjskim centrima i wellness turizmu u Turskoj i u svetu. Pozvani smo da održimo predavanje na temu: Rehabilitation at Thermal Spas, Experience and Expertise; Serbian Example. Najpre je dr Jokić održao predavanje o mogućnostima banjskog lečenja i wellness-a u Banji Koviljači, a potom je dr Stojković iznela mogućnosti korišćenja sumporovitog peloida kod dece. Slušaoci su bili iznenadeni brojem fizikalnih procedura i balneoprocedura koje se svakodnevno sprovode u Banji Koviljači, broju pacijenata na godišnjem nivou, opremljenosti naše Bolnice, kadrovima... a posebno interesovanje su pokazali za lečenje dece balneoterapijom, jer takva iskustva u svetu su retkost.

Pored ovih predavanja imali smo dosta bilateralnih sastanaka sa predstavnicima bolnica i turističkih organizacija.

Poseban značaj za nas bio je u tome što je predsednik turskog udruženja banja, Prof.dr Zeki Karagulle, ujedno i predsednik međunarodnog udruženja balneoklimatologa (ISMH) bio naš glavni domaćin u Antaliji, tako da smo „iz prve ruke“ informisani o dešavanjima u svetskoj balneoklimatologiji.

Obavešteni smo da ćemo kao ustanova biti uključeni u međunarodnu studiju o delovanju balneoterapije, utvrđili teme predavanja za sledeći svetski kongres balneoklimatologa (Španija 2012), i dobili ponudu za organizovanje međunarodnog sastanka balneoklimatologa u Banji Koviljači 2013.

Za ovo učešće dobili smo i prigodna priznanja, ali nas je najviše obradovala informacija da je jedan balneolog iz Srbije, dr Aleksandar Jokić iz Banje Koviljače, uvršten u Naučni komitet međunarodnog udruženja balneoklimatologa (ISMH).

Two physicians from the Specialized Rehabilitation Hospital in Banja Koviljaca (Serbia), Prim. Negosava Stojkovic, MD, pediatric physiatrist, and Prim. Aleksandar Jokic, MD, MSc, physiatrist-balneologist, were special guests of this year's manifestation. Being invited lecturers, they had an opportunity to introduce their treatment experiences from Banja Koviljaca, a leader in medical tourism in Serbia, to attendants of this manifestation. The Ministry for Culture and Tourism of the Republic of Turkey via the Embassy in Belgrade organized our complete stay.

On the first day, the Turkish Spa Society held the panel on trends in spa centers and wellness tourism in both Turkey and in the world. We were invited to provide lectures with the following subject: Rehabilitation at Thermal Spas, Experience and Expertise; Serbian Example. Initially, Doctor Jokic held a lecture on possibilities of the spa treatment and wellness in Banja Koviljaca, and afterwards, Doctor Stojkovic presented possibilities of using the sulphuric mud in children. Attendants were surprised with the amount of physical procedures and balneological procedures carried out in Banja Koviljaca on daily basis, the number of patients per year, the present equipment in our institution, our staff, and they were particularly interested in the balneological treatment of children for this kind of experience is rare in the world.

Apart from these lectures, we had many bilateral meetings with representatives of hospitals and tourism organizations.

It was particularly significant to us for the president of the Turkey Spa Society, Prof. Dr. Zeki Karagulle, being also the president of the International Society of Medical Hydrology and Climatology (ISMH), was our host in Antalya, so we were directly informed on events in world's balneoclimatology.

We were informed that our institution will be involved in the international study on effects of balneotherapy, together we set lecture topics for the next world congress of balneoclimatology (Spain 2012), and we received an offer for organizing the international meeting of balneoclimatologists in Banja Koviljaca in 2013.

We received pertinent rewards, but we were most delighted with the information that a balneologist from Serbia, Dr. Aleksandar Jokic from Banja Koviljaca, was ranked in the Scientific Committee of the International Society of Medical Hydrology and Climatology (ISMH).
